The whole "CEM Air Quality Surveillance Network" is qualified to be integrated with the "Pearl River Delta Regional Air Quality Monitoring Network" with real-time monitoring Sulfur Dioxide (SO₂), Nitrogen Oxides (NO_x, NO, NO₂), Carbon Monoxide (CO), Ozone (O₃) and Particulate Matters (PM10 and PM2.5), greatly enhances the region's air quality monitoring capability.
