## We safeguard your health

Nowadays, more and more people show concerns about the effects of electromagnetic fields on public health. As electromagnetic fields are a physical phenomenon generated by electrical equipment, we cannot avoid to be exposed to a mix of weak electromagnetic fields, both at home and at work, surrounded by all types of electrical equipment.

Acceptable limits for exposure to electromagnetic fields emitted by electrical equipment, as recommended by the International Commission on Non-Ionizing Radiation Protection (ICNIRP), is 100µT (1,000 mG). You can rest assured that for all CEM electrical equipment, located at different areas of the city, the **value of electromagnetic fields is far below the standard levels**. They will not create any harm to your health.
