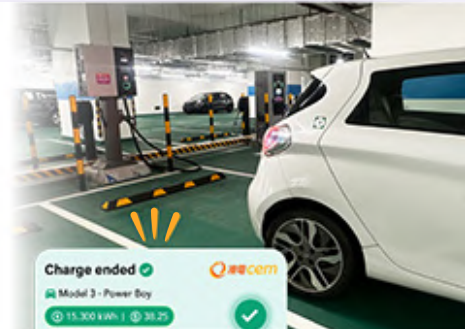

- 3 **Power Suspended** – Power is currently off
- 4 **Restoration Begins** – We're working to restore power
- 5 **Restoration Complete** – Let us know if your power hasn't returned
